Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?
Psalm 85:6

Introduction

Throughout Scripture, every great movement of God began with ordinary people who sought Him with extraordinary faith. Before revival was seen publicly, it was experienced personally. Hearts were humbled. Lives were surrendered. God's people united in prayer, and the Lord moved in power.

As we prepare for Revival Nights, we invite you to spend the next ten days intentionally seeking God. Each day includes a passage of Scripture, a short devotional, and a guided prayer focus designed to help prepare your heart while praying for our church, our families, and our region.

Our prayer is not simply for a great event. We are asking God for something far greater. We are praying for genuine spiritual renewal. We are praying for salvation. We are praying for lives to be transformed by the Gospel of Jesus Christ. We are praying for the Holy Spirit to ignite a fresh fire that spreads throughout Northeast Florida and beyond.

May these next ten days draw you closer to Jesus and prepare your heart for everything He desires to do.

DAY 1 • September 19

A Fresh Fire Begins With Me

Key Scripture

Psalms 51:10-12

"Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit"

Devotional

Revival always begins before it is seen. God first prepares hearts before He transforms churches, communities, and nations. David understood this after his greatest failure. Rather than asking God to change the people around him, he first cried out for God to renew his own heart. That is where revival always starts. Fresh fire is not produced through emotion, personality, or better programs. It is the work of the Holy Spirit in surrendered people. God delights in filling hearts that are humble, repentant, and fully dependent upon Him. As we begin these ten days of prayer, resist the temptation to focus on what God needs to change around you. Instead, ask Him what He wants to change within you. Invite Him to search every area of your heart, remove distractions, renew your passion for Christ, and prepare you for everything He desires to accomplish during Revival Nights. When God sets one heart on fire, He often uses it to ignite many others.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would search your heart and reveal anything that is hindering your relationship with Him. Ask Him to forgive any unconfessed sin, soften areas that have grown spiritually calloused, and remove every distraction that has taken your focus away from Christ. Pray that He would renew your love for His Word, deepen your desire for prayer, and give you a greater hunger for His presence every day. Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you afresh with His power, producing greater faith, joy, humility, obedience, and boldness to live as a faithful witness for Jesus. Pray that your life would reflect the character of Christ both publicly and privately. Finally, ask God to prepare your heart for Revival Nights and allow the fresh fire He begins in you to overflow into your family, your workplace, our church, and our community.

DAY 2 • September 20

Humble Hearts Before a Holy God

Key Scripture

2 Chronicles 7:14

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

Devotional

One of the most familiar promises in Scripture begins with an important reminder: revival starts with God's people. The Lord did not call Israel to fix their culture before seeking Him. He called His people to humble themselves, pray, seek His face, and turn from their sin. Spiritual renewal has always begun with believers responding to God's invitation. Humility is not weakness. It is recognizing who God is and acknowledging our complete dependence upon Him. Pride says, "I can handle this." Humility says, "Apart from Christ, I can do nothing." As we seek the Lord today, remember that God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble. Revival flourishes wherever humble hearts are fully surrendered to the Lord.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would cultivate genuine humility in your own heart and throughout Mill Creek Baptist Church. Ask Him to expose pride, self reliance, spiritual complacency, and anything that keeps you from depending completely upon Him. Pray that we would seek God's presence more than His blessings and desire His glory above our own comfort. Ask the Lord to bring repentance where it is needed, healing where there is brokenness, forgiveness where there has been offense, and restoration where relationships have been strained. Pray that our church would become known as a people who consistently humble themselves before God, faithfully obey His Word, and joyfully pursue His will.

DAY 3 • September 21

A Fresh Filling of the Holy Spirit

Key Scripture

Ephesians 5:18

“...be filled with the Spirit”

Devotional

The Christian life was never intended to be lived in our own strength. God has given every believer His Holy Spirit to empower us for holy living, faithful witness, and joyful obedience. Paul's command to “be filled with the Spirit” is continual. Yesterday's faithfulness is not enough for today. We need fresh strength, fresh wisdom, fresh courage, and fresh dependence upon God every day. The Holy Spirit doesn't simply help us do ministry. He transforms us into people who increasingly look like Jesus. As He fills our lives, He produces His fruit, directs our steps, convicts us of sin, comforts us in difficulty, and empowers us to boldly proclaim the Gospel. As Revival Nights approach, our greatest need is not better preparation or greater ability. Our greatest need is the powerful presence of God.

Prayer Focus

Pray that the Holy Spirit would fill you afresh today and produce His fruit in every area of your life. Ask Him to strengthen your faith, increase your love for others, deepen your trust in God's Word, and give you wisdom for every decision you face. Invite Him to make you more sensitive to His leading and more willing to obey His voice. Pray for pastor Justin Pratt, the music service, production team and any servants who help make Revival Nights possible. Ask God to empower them with humility, joy, unity, wisdom, and spiritual strength. Pray that every worship experience would be marked by the unmistakable presence of God, and that everything we do would point people to Jesus Christ rather than ourselves.

DAY 4 • September 22

Revival in Our Church

Key Scripture

Habakkuk 3:2

"O LORD, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy."

Devotional

Habakkuk looked around and saw a nation in desperate need of God's intervention. His prayer wasn't simply for relief from difficult circumstances. He prayed that God would revive His work once again. That same prayer should rise from our hearts today. We are thankful for all God has done at Mill Creek Baptist Church, but we never want to become satisfied with yesterday's victories. Every generation must experience a fresh work of God. Every believer must pursue a fresh dependence on Him. Every church must continually seek the presence and power of the Holy Spirit. Programs can gather people. Excellence can create environments. But only God can transform hearts. As Revival Nights draw closer, let's pray that God would renew His work in our church. May every worship experience become a place where people encounter the living Christ. May every ministry be strengthened. May every volunteer serve with joy. May every message faithfully proclaim the Gospel. Above all, may Jesus be glorified in everything we do.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would bring genuine spiritual renewal throughout every ministry of Mill Creek Baptist Church. Ask Him to strengthen our pastors, ministry leaders, volunteers, and every person who faithfully serves behind the scenes. Pray that they would lead with humility, wisdom, integrity, and complete dependence upon the Holy Spirit. Ask God to protect our church from discouragement, division, distraction, and spiritual complacency. Pray that our worship would be Christ-centered, our preaching would be faithful to God's Word, and our fellowship would reflect the love of Jesus. Ask the Lord to deepen discipleship, strengthen families, raise up new leaders, and continue building a church that passionately connects people to an authentic life in Christ. Pray that Revival Nights would not simply be a series of services, but the beginning of a fresh work of God that continues long after the final message has been preached.

DAY 5 • September 23

Prayer for the Lost

Key Scripture

Luke 19:10

"For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Devotional

The heartbeat of Jesus has always been people. Throughout the Gospels, we find Him pursuing the forgotten, the broken, the skeptical, and the sinful. No one was beyond His grace. No life was too far gone. His mission was clear: to seek and save the lost. That same mission is now ours. Revival is never only for those already inside the church. True revival always overflows into evangelism. As God revives His people, He compels them to reach those who do not yet know Christ. As Revival Nights approach, remember that every invitation matters. Someone's eternity may be changed because you were willing to pray, invite, love, and share the hope of Jesus. Today, pray with specific names in mind. Ask God to prepare hearts before they ever walk through the doors.

Prayer Focus

Pray for family members, friends, neighbors, coworkers, classmates, and anyone God has placed in your life who does not yet know Jesus Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to soften hardened hearts, remove spiritual blindness, and awaken people to their need for a Savior. Pray that many prodigals would return home and that those who have never trusted Christ would experience His saving grace. Ask God to give every person at Mill Creek Baptist Church a burden for the lost and the courage to personally invite someone to Revival Nights. Pray that every conversation would be led by love, wisdom, and truth. Ask the Lord to bring people from every background, every generation, and every walk of life, and that many would respond to the Gospel in repentance and faith. Pray that heaven would rejoice as lives are forever changed by Jesus Christ.

DAY 6 • September 24

Boldness to Share the Gosple

Key Scripture

Romans 1:16

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth..."

Devotional

The Gospel is not simply good advice. It is the good news that Jesus Christ lived the perfect life we could never live, died the death we deserve, and rose again in victory over sin and death. That message still changes lives today. Sometimes fear keeps us silent. We worry about saying the wrong thing, being rejected, or making someone uncomfortable. Yet Scripture reminds us that the power is not found in our ability to persuade. The power is found in the Gospel itself. God has intentionally placed each of us in neighborhoods, workplaces, schools, gyms, coffee shops, and communities where we can represent Christ. We may be the only follower of Jesus someone encounters this week. As Revival Nights approach, let's ask God to replace hesitation with holy boldness and fear with faithful obedience.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would give you courage to boldly and lovingly share your faith with others. Ask Him to open doors for meaningful spiritual conversations and to help you recognize divine appointments throughout your day. Pray that the Holy Spirit would give you wisdom to know what to say, compassion that reflects the heart of Christ, and confidence that rests in the truth of the Gospel rather than your own abilities. Ask the Lord to remove fear, insecurity, and hesitation from every believer in our church. Pray that every invitation extended to Revival Nights would become an opportunity for someone to encounter Jesus. Ask God to empower our church to faithfully proclaim the Gospel with clarity, conviction, and love, believing that His Word still has the power to save, transform, and give eternal life.

DAY 7 • September 25

Unity in the Body of Christ

Key Scripture

John 17:20-23

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.

Devotional

On the night before His crucifixion, Jesus prayed for His Church. His prayer was not for larger crowds, greater influence, or easier circumstances. He prayed for unity. Biblical unity is not built upon personalities, preferences, or traditions. It is rooted in the Gospel. We are one because Christ has made us one. When believers walk together in humility, forgiveness, and love, the world catches a glimpse of the transforming power of Jesus. The enemy knows the strength of a unified church. That is why he works so diligently to create division, offense, comparison, and distraction. But when God's people choose grace over criticism, encouragement over division, and humility over pride, the Church becomes a powerful witness to the Gospel. As Revival Nights approach, let's pray that God would strengthen the unity of His Church. May we serve one another with joy, honor one another with humility, and stand together for the advancement of the Gospel.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would deepen the unity of Mill Creek Baptist Church as we prepare for Revival Nights. Ask Him to remove any spirit of division, comparison, pride, offense, or discouragement that could distract us from His mission. Pray that every ministry, every volunteer, and every leader would work together with humility, joy, and a shared passion to make Jesus known. Pray also for churches across Northeast Florida that faithfully proclaim the Gospel. Ask God to strengthen pastors, encourage ministry leaders, and pour out His Spirit throughout our region. Pray that the Church would be known for its love, its faithfulness to God's Word, and its unwavering commitment to the Great Commission. May our unity point people to Christ, and may God use His Church to bring hope and healing to our communities.

DAY 8 • September 26

The Next Generation on Fire for God

Key Scripture

Psalms 145:4

"One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts."

Devotional

Every generation must personally encounter Jesus. No one inherits a relationship with Christ. Every child, every teen, and every young adult must come to know Him personally. Throughout Scripture, God faithfully raised up new generations of leaders who loved Him, trusted Him, and boldly carried His truth forward. Our responsibility is to faithfully pass the Gospel to those who come after us. Today, our children and teens face tremendous cultural pressure. They need more than good advice or positive encouragement. They need the truth of God's Word, the power of the Holy Spirit, and the support of a church that believes in them. As we pray today, let's ask God to raise up a generation that is unashamed of the Gospel, grounded in Scripture, passionate in worship, and committed to making disciples wherever He leads them.

Prayer Focus

Pray for every child, teen, young adult, and young family at Mill Creek Baptist Church. Ask God to draw them into a genuine and lasting relationship with Jesus Christ. Pray that they would develop a deep love for God's Word, a consistent prayer life, and a bold faith that remains steadfast in every season. Lift up parents, grandparents, teachers, and ministry leaders who are investing in the next generation. Ask God to give them wisdom, patience, and endurance as they faithfully disciple young people. Pray that the Lord would raise up future pastors, missionaries, church planters, worship leaders, and faithful servants who will proclaim the Gospel for generations to come. May Revival Nights become a defining spiritual moment in the lives of many young people who answer God's call on their lives.

DAY 9 • September 27

Expecting God to Move

Key Scripture

Ephesians 3:20–21

"Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen"

Devotional

Tomorrow we gather. For the past nine days we have prayed, sought the Lord, humbled ourselves, and prepared our hearts. Now we come with expectation. Biblical faith is confident because it rests in the character of God. We are not expecting God to move because of our planning, our preparation, or our efforts. We are expecting Him to move because He is faithful. He still saves sinners. He still restores broken lives. He still heals, delivers, calls, strengthens, and transforms people through the power of the Gospel. As Revival Nights begin tomorrow, let's arrive with hearts full of anticipation. Come ready to worship. Come ready to listen. Come ready to respond. Most importantly, come believing that God desires to accomplish more than we could ever ask or imagine for His glory.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would prepare every heart that will gather during Revival Nights. Ask Him to remove distractions, soften hearts, and create a spirit of expectancy throughout our church. Pray that every person would come ready to hear His Word, respond in obedience, and encounter the presence of Jesus Christ in a life-changing way. Ask the Lord to move powerfully through every message, every worship experience, every prayer gathering, and every conversation throughout the week. Pray for salvation, healing, freedom, restoration, encouragement, and renewed faith. Ask God to accomplish far more than we could ever ask or imagine and to receive all the glory for every life He transforms.

DAY 10 • September 28

Fresh Fire for Our Region

Key Scripture

Acts 2:17

"And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh..."

Devotional

Tonight we gather with one prayer: "Lord, do it again." We are not asking for emotional moments or memorable services. We are asking for a genuine movement of God. Throughout history, revival has never been about personalities or platforms. It has always been about the presence of God transforming ordinary people for His extraordinary purposes. When the Holy Spirit moves, sinners are saved, prodigals come home, marriages are restored, chains are broken, believers are renewed, and churches are strengthened. Our prayer is bigger than these Three nights. We are asking God to begin something that continues long after Revival Nights have ended. May this be the beginning of lasting spiritual renewal throughout Northeast Florida and beyond. May future generations look back and say, "God visited His people." Tonight, let's gather with faith, humility, and expectancy, believing that Jesus Christ is worthy of our complete devotion and that His Gospel still has the power to change lives.

Prayer Focus

Pray that God would pour out His Spirit in a powerful and unmistakable way throughout Revival Nights. Ask Him to anoint Pastor Justin Pratt with boldness, wisdom, humility, and a fresh word from His Spirit. Pray for every Pastor, Singer, production team member, volunteer, prayer team member, children's ministry leader, and staff member, that they would serve with joy, excellence, unity, and complete dependence upon the Holy Spirit. Ask God to draw people from every corner of our region, especially those who are far from Him, discouraged, searching, or spiritually lost. Pray that every person who walks through the doors would experience the love of Christ, hear the truth of the Gospel clearly proclaimed, and respond with repentance and faith. Ask the Lord to bring salvation to the lost, freedom to those in bondage, healing to the broken, restoration to families, renewed passion to believers, and fresh calling to those He is sending into ministry. Finally, pray that this would be more than a powerful event.

Ask God to ignite a lasting movement of spiritual renewal throughout Northeast Florida that spreads from homes to neighborhoods, from churches to communities, and from one generation to the next. Above all, pray that Jesus Christ alone would be exalted, His Kingdom advanced, and His name glorified through everything He accomplishes during Revival Nights and beyond.

Closing Prayer

Father, Thank You for meeting with us over these past ten days. Thank You for reminding us that revival begins with surrendered hearts and that every movement of God starts with people who humble themselves before You. As we enter Revival Night, we do so with confidence in Your promises and complete dependence upon Your Spirit. We ask You to move in ways that only You can. Save the lost. Restore the wandering. Strengthen Your Church. Raise up leaders. Heal the broken. Renew our passion for Jesus and our commitment to Your mission. May these not simply be memorable gatherings but the beginning of a lasting work of spiritual renewal throughout our church, our city, and our region. May every message proclaim Christ, every song magnify Your name, every prayer honor You, and every life reflect the transforming power of the Gospel. We ask all of this in the mighty and matchless name of Jesus Christ, our Savior and King. Amen.
